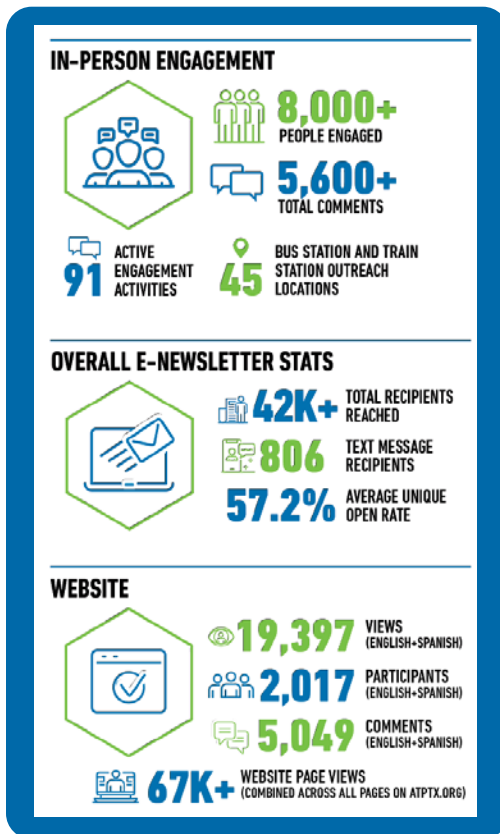


## » LIGHT RAIL COMMUNITY DIALOGUE

The CAC advises agency partners on topics related to equity and Project Connect, including efforts to minimize impacts of displacement along Project Connect transit corridors.
